It's one of the most structured, powerful Haut-Bailly I've ever tasted, yet it still has the classic elegance, nuance, and length of this terrific terroir. It will need 5-7 years (or more) of bottle age but will have 50 years of overall longevity. **96-98+**

The 2020 Haut-Bailly was picked September 9–25 in what the estate has called the "year of reinvention." Having left my sample to open for 30 minutes and then assessed it over the following three hours, I found that it has a mercurial nose of gorgeous blackberry, briar, white pepper, incense and hints of blood orange. It gains intensity and becomes more floral with aeration. The palate is medium-bodied with supple but firm tannins that provide backbone. There is plenty of black fruit laced with white pepper and clove. Perhaps less rich on the finish compared to the last two vintages – a virtue as far as I am concerned, as it allows more terroir to show through. This is an impressive Haut-Bailly to coincide with their new winery, which I hope to visit very soon. **95-97**

Deeply colored, the wine explodes with fresh flowers, tobacco leaf, cigar box, currants, blackberry, Allspice, licorice, savory herbs and smoke aromas. On the palate, the wine is intense, balanced, silky and refined. The fruits express purity, harmony, length and complexity, finishing with layers of currants, blackberry, herbs, pepper and plums that hold your focus for at least 50 seconds. Give this at least 10-12 years of age. It will evolve and provide sensuous tasting for at least 25 or more years after that. **97-99**

A great wine with excellent tension, very deep, intense purple colour with violet hue and black core. **Very noble nose**, well concentrated with a wonderfully perfumed character. Blackcurrants and elderberries, floral hints, mallow blossoms, hints of liquorice, subtle oak, very complex with impressive elegance. On the palate juicy fruit, strawberries, blackberries. Powerful structured with massive ripe tannins, appetizing freshness, combining the power of 2016 and 2018 with the freshness of 2019. Expressive fruit, elegant spiciness and fine oak in the background. **A truly impressive wine. 98+**

Rich in texture and colour, this has clear layers and complexity, a wine that you want to take your time with, slow down and enjoy. One that will take its time to age also. This has a **precision** and a **clarity to the aromatics**, and a gentle buzz of minerality that gives a physical reaction in the mouth. Less exuberant than the 2018 or 2019, making this a vintage that suits the style of Haut-Bailly. A slight austerity to the tannins on the finish gives a blueberry redcurrant edge. 3% Petit Verdot completes the blend (now around eight years old), usually co-fermented with the Cabernet Sauvignon (sometimes with Cabernet Franc). IPT similar to 2016, 2010, 2005, but with a **softness that comes from extremely ripe tannins**. Strong potential for upscoring when it bottle. **96**

Ruby. Blackberries, anise, fruit driven, nuanced, detailed, layered nose, floral high notes. Fresh acidity, ripe tannins, dark fruits, detailed, layered, lots of depth, anise, spices, structured, **focused, both linear and broad, long. 97-99**

Tasted alongside Haut-Bailly II, this shows a very similar violet-black hue, the obvious difference here being a major step up in concentration, the wine exhibiting a lightly dusty and near-opaque density in the glass. A quite brilliant nose here; it is not as immediately flattering as that of Haut-Bailly II (nor, I suppose, should it be), but you can sense the focus and intent here. It is **brilliantly defined**, with a tight core of blackcurrant and currant fruits, wrapped up with black bean, dark chocolate and cherry blossom scents, with a little lick of new oak. Beautifully defined on the palate, **such focused fruits**, lithe and sinewy though, rather than broad or weighty, rich with dark currant and damson, **so fragrant and perfumed**, set in a neatly defined texture, and tightly fenced in by its wrapping of **very fine tannins** and slowly unfurling tobacco oak. There is such **great concentration** here, yet also such **fine precision**, the wine just deftly skipping across the midpalate. **An absolutely stunning Haut-Bailly this year. 97-99**

The nose is elegant and discreet, slightly offering savory spices and graceful black fruits. Strands of ink-like scent describe a unique charm that I often find in Chinese landscape painting. The entry is extraordinarily **refined and classy, adorned with a creamy texture and streamlined structure**. Tannins are possessive yet perfectly polished, infusing into the velvet and round body like falling into a cup of smooth chocolate milk. As a hot vintage, **Haut-Bailly 2020 shows me a supreme example of achieving a harmonious balance. 97-99**

This is a delicious Haut-Bailly with a thrilling perfume of perfectly ripe grapes and discreet leaf details. The oak is firm and it buttresses the dense, dark fruit beautifully. Bold, regal and amazingly well-balanced considering its powerful stance, this is a long, fine wine with lip-smacking tannins and a welcoming kick of brightness and joy right on the finish. While the overall tone is of a contemplative soul as opposed to an extrovert, this is a delicious Haut-Bailly and when you dive into the serene black fruit and allow your palate to swim around its cathedral-like caverns of flavour there is a stunning sensation of freshness when you eventually come up for air. This is a wine that will be sure to open and reveal itself younger in its life than the past handful of vintages but I venture its staying power will be extraordinary, too. **19+**

Haut Bailly 2020 is **extremely refined, suave and elegant** on the nose, with the signature floral and herbal notes of the vintage. (...) The **considerable concentration and density** is fantastically well disguised. This unfurls beautifully, with the grain of the tannins very slowly revealing themselves and helping to stretch the fruit out over the mineral-saline backbone of the wine toward a **lovely sappy, juicy finish. 94-96+**

This wine's texture is **exceptional**, with powerful dark fruits and rich tannins blending seamlessly. All this density is cut with the finest spice and fresh acidity. The result is a wine that has both **power** and **delicacy** that gives a lift to the aftertaste. It will certainly age so well. **96-98**
